## **Academic Job Materials Checklist**

Below is a checklist of materials frequently required when applying to academic jobs. You may not need all of the materials for every application, but you'll probably need most of these materials at some point during your academic job search. While it's a good idea to have versions of these materials prepared ahead of time, you'll still want to tailor them for individual applications.   - □ Overview of a course you've taught, including:
    - □ Course description and rationale
    - □ Methods used to assess student learning
    - □ Examples of assignments, examinations, and/or student work
    - □ Examples of innovative teaching methods used
    - □ Student evaluations of the course
    - □ Your evaluation of the course including the relationship between course design and your philosophy of teaching
  - □ <u>Optional</u>: Overview of a second course you've taught (same format as above)
  - □ Teaching awards and recognition
  - □ Teaching-related and professional development activities

## □ 3-4 Letters of Recommendation

- □ For teaching positions, 1-2 should speak to your teaching abilities.
- □ Writing Sample (more common for Humanities positions)
